


Total Contributions by Fund

Contributions to all funds totaled \$3,280,598 in 2011.




Total Contributions by Source

Shelburne Farms depends upon support from diverse private and public funding sources.




Contributor Demographics


In 2011 Shelburne Farms received contributions from 3,626 individuals, businesses and foundations in 44 states and 7 foreign countries and territories.





Total Number of Contributors



Financial Trends, 1984 – 2011 (In thousands of dollars)











Net Available for Capital Needs from Operations & Unrestricted Gifts (before depreciation)
