#### **PROGRAMS**

We design, deliver, and host transformative educational programs for educators and students to help inspire an emerging generation of changemakers. We do this together with a global network of collaborators in education, sustainability, and food systems.

#### **PLACE**

We welcome everyone to explore the big ideas of sustainability on our diversified working farm — and to uncover these ideas in the places around the world that they call home. Our entire historic campus is a living classroom that invites program participants, day visitors, and overnight guests to enjoy its beauty and to learn, grow, and be inspired.

## **PRODUCTS**

We practice regenerative agriculture to craft farm products and meals. Everything we produce connects learners to the working landscape and helps them better understand their role in sustainable food systems.

# **Climate Action**

Implement initiatives to achieve net zero on our campus by 2028 and advance climate action through education for sustainability globally.

- Invest in conservation, efficiency, and renewables and achieve 100% renewable energy for facilities heating and cooling.
- Increase soil carbon sequestration and reduce livestock greenhouse gas emissions through innovative practices such as grass-based livestock farming, silvopasture, and use of biochar.
- Develop and begin implementing a woodlands management plan that centers carbon sequestration and climate resiliency.
- Advance climate action and environmental justice by developing and offering Education for Sustainability programs and resources for educators around the world.
- Enhance and create new learning experiences around our net-zero initiatives to leverage their impact.





## Capacity

Continue to build our adaptive, learning organization to meet our strategic goals and future challenges.

- Build succession readiness for board and staff, including articulating organizational guiding principles and values.
- Raise the charitable resources needed for continuing campus improvements and program development, and for long-term organizational success.
- Keep adapting our business model around the appropriate scale and integration of activities and audiences.
- Evolve our organizational systems to better support complexity, interdependence, collaborative decision-making and professional learning.
- Evaluate and strengthen our communications to advance the mission.
- Strengthen the shared understanding and value of the farm in Shelburne Farms.
- Strengthen HR systems and support, including addressing equitable compensation, benefits, and other barriers to staffing and operational sustainability.
